Countries of Origin Information

USDA Grade

This material is sourced in countries approved for import into the United States by the USDA. While this is the case, this grade of material is NOT USDA approved – it is only approved for import and use from USDA approved countries. Currently, this includes Canada, Mexico, Panama, Costa Rica, El Salvador, Nicaragua, Honduras, Guatemala, Belize, Australia, New Zealand and Chile. This material is collected and processed in facilities registered and inspected by the competent veterinary authority in the country of origin. In many instances, the material cannot be distributed within the US without completion of USDA safety testing.

EU Grade

This material is sourced in countries approved for import into the European Union by the European Commission. Currently, this includes countries from North, Central and South America, Australia, New Zealand and South Africa.

Definitions of Country of Origin

Australian Origin

This is material sourced from DAWR (Department of Agriculture and Water Resources) registered facilities inspected by the competent veterinary authority in Australia.

Canadian Origin

This serum is sourced from CFIA (Canadian Food Inspection Agency) registered facilities inspected by the competent veterinary authority in Canada.

Central American and Caribbean Origin

This material is sourced from registered facilities that are inspected by the competent veterinary authority in the specific Central American or Caribbean country of origin.

EU Origin

This material is sourced from EU registered facilities inspected by the competent veterinary authority inside the European Union.

New Zealand Origin

This material is sourced from NZFSA (New Zealand Food Safety Authority) registered facilities inspected by the competent veterinary authority in New Zealand.

Mexican Origin

This serum is sourced from SAGARPA (Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock, Rural Development, Fisheries and Food) registered facilities inspected by the competent veterinary authority in Mexico.

South American Origin

This material is sourced from specific countries in South America that are registered and inspected by the competent veterinary authority in the specific country.

USA Origin

This material is sourced from USDA (United States Department of Agriculture) registered facilities inspected by the competent veterinary authority in the United States of America
