



Privacy Policy

International Serum Industry Association (ISIA) is committed to respecting the privacy rights of all members and visitors to our website. The following information (“Privacy Policy”) details ISIA’s collection, protection, and use of the data we receive from members and visitors to this website.

ISIA reserves the right at any time to change this Privacy Policy. Member Privacy and Information We Collect

Internet Protocol Address
